

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

Below you will find PACKZ general terms and conditions for purchasing a ticket to our event.

## Article 1 – Definitions

PACKZ B.V., a company, incorporated and existing under the laws of the Netherlands, having its principle place of business at Breda

Seminar or Packaging Experience Tour: a event named 'Seminar' or 'Packaging Experience Tour', organised by PACKZ

General Terms & Conditions: these general terms & conditions

Participant: each party, being a natural person or legal person, participating in any way in an event

## Article 2 – Registration fee

2.1 Participants who wish to attend PACKZ' event can register for the event online on PACKZ.org or at eventbrite.com. The attendance fee is due upon registration. It is payable immediately upon receipt of the invoice.

2.2 For each registration for the event, payment of a registration fee is due, unless otherwise agreed between a Participant and PACKZ. The registration fees applicable are set forth on [www.PACKZ.org](http://www.PACKZ.org). Payment of the registration fee can be made online via the eventbrite website through a secure server. Under certain circumstances, the registration fee can also be paid by invoice.

2.3 After payment of the registration fee is received by PACKZ, the participant will receive a confirmation of its registration. With this confirmation, the participant shall be able to join the seminar.

## Article 3 – Participation

3.1 The number of Participants that can attend the event, or parts thereof, is limited. Registrations are handled on a first-come, first-served basis. If the maximum number of Participants of (parts of) the event is reached, PACKZ have the right to refuse a registration. Moreover, PACKZ retain the right to reject any Participant.

3.2 PACKZ reserves the right to amend and adapt the event's programme and speakers' list of the seminar.

## Article 4 – Liability

4.1 PACKZ will under no circumstances be liable for any damages whatsoever arising from the refusal of a registration.

4.2 PACKZ shall not be liable for any damages of a Participant arising in connection with PACKZ.

4.3 Under no circumstance shall PACKZ be liable for any damage arising pursuant to a situation of force majeure. The expression "force majeure" shall mean and include any circumstance or occurrence beyond PACKZ' reasonable control - whether or not foreseeable at the time of registration - in consequence of which PACKZ cannot reasonably be required to execute its obligations. Such circumstances or occurrences explicitly include but are not restricted to: war, fires, floods, earthquakes, our disputes, strikes, epidemics, governmental regulations and/or similar acts, embargoes, defaults of suppliers or subcontractors, disruption of electricity supplies, the non-availability of telecommunication services and withdrawal of the local governments.

#### Article 5 – Cancellation and transfer

5.1 Should the Participant be unable to attend the seminar for any reason, the Participant may transfer the registration to another person within its organization or company at any time by providing written notice to the following email address: [info@PACKZ.org](mailto:info@PACKZ.org).

5.2 We reserve the right to cancel or change in schedule at least two weeks prior to the scheduled start date of the event. We will not be responsible for any travel, living or other costs incurred by participants as a result of a cancellation or rescheduling of a event.
